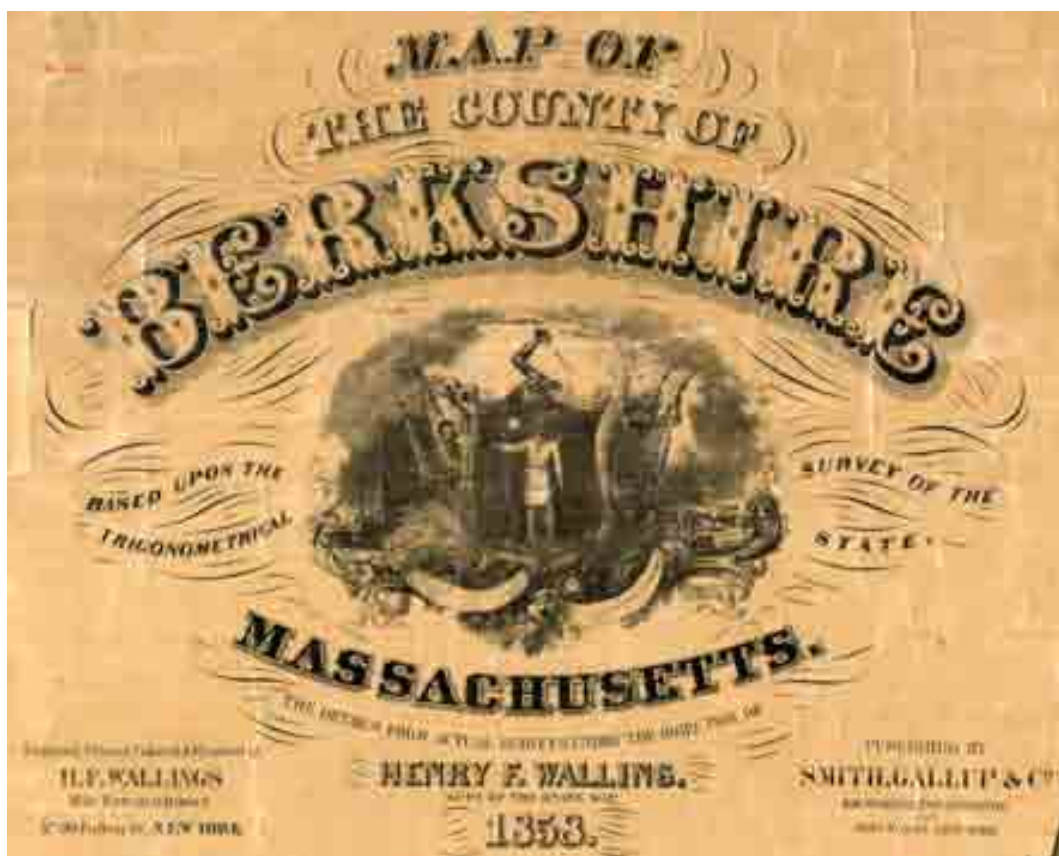


Map of Berkshire County, MA 1858

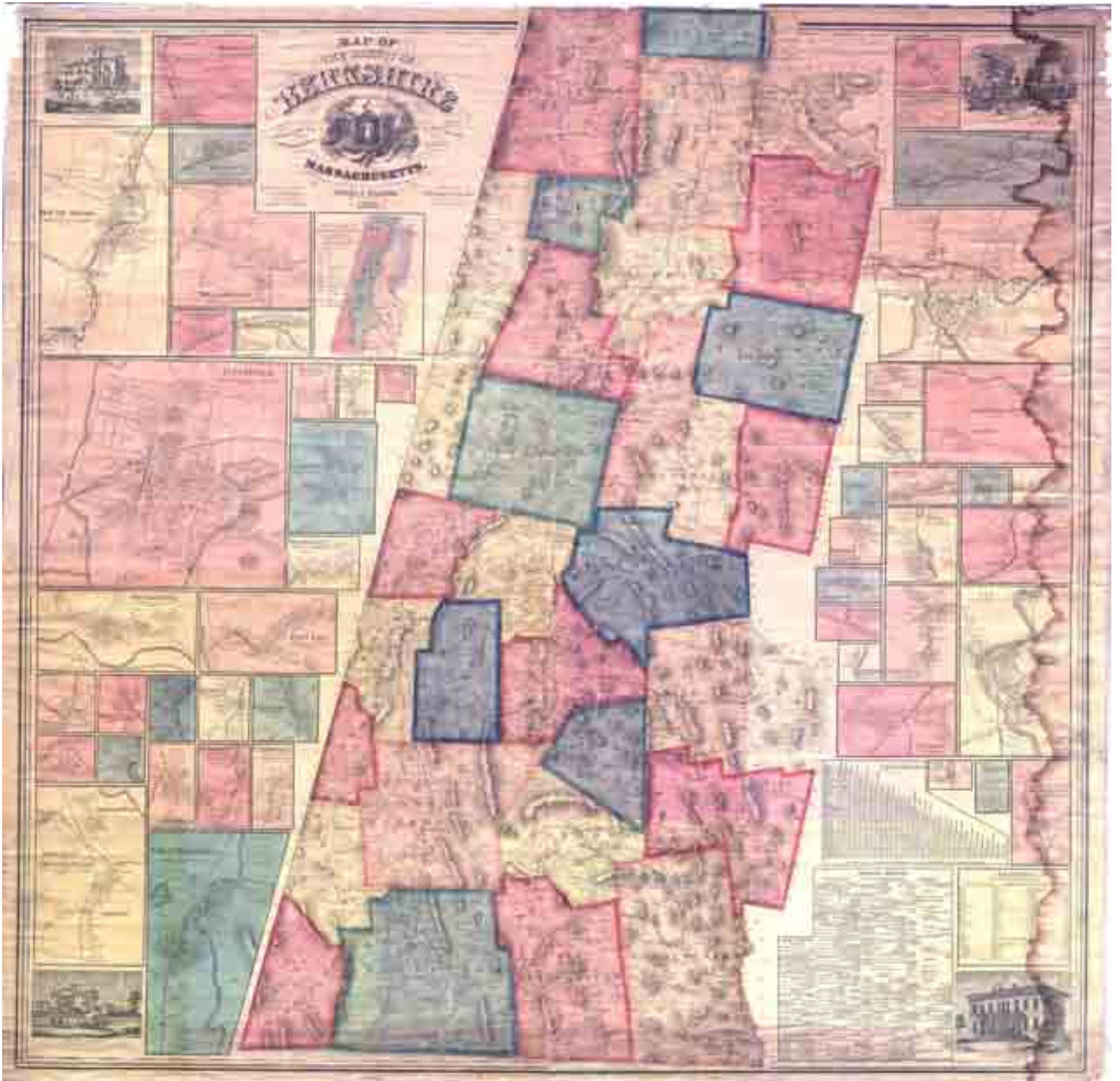

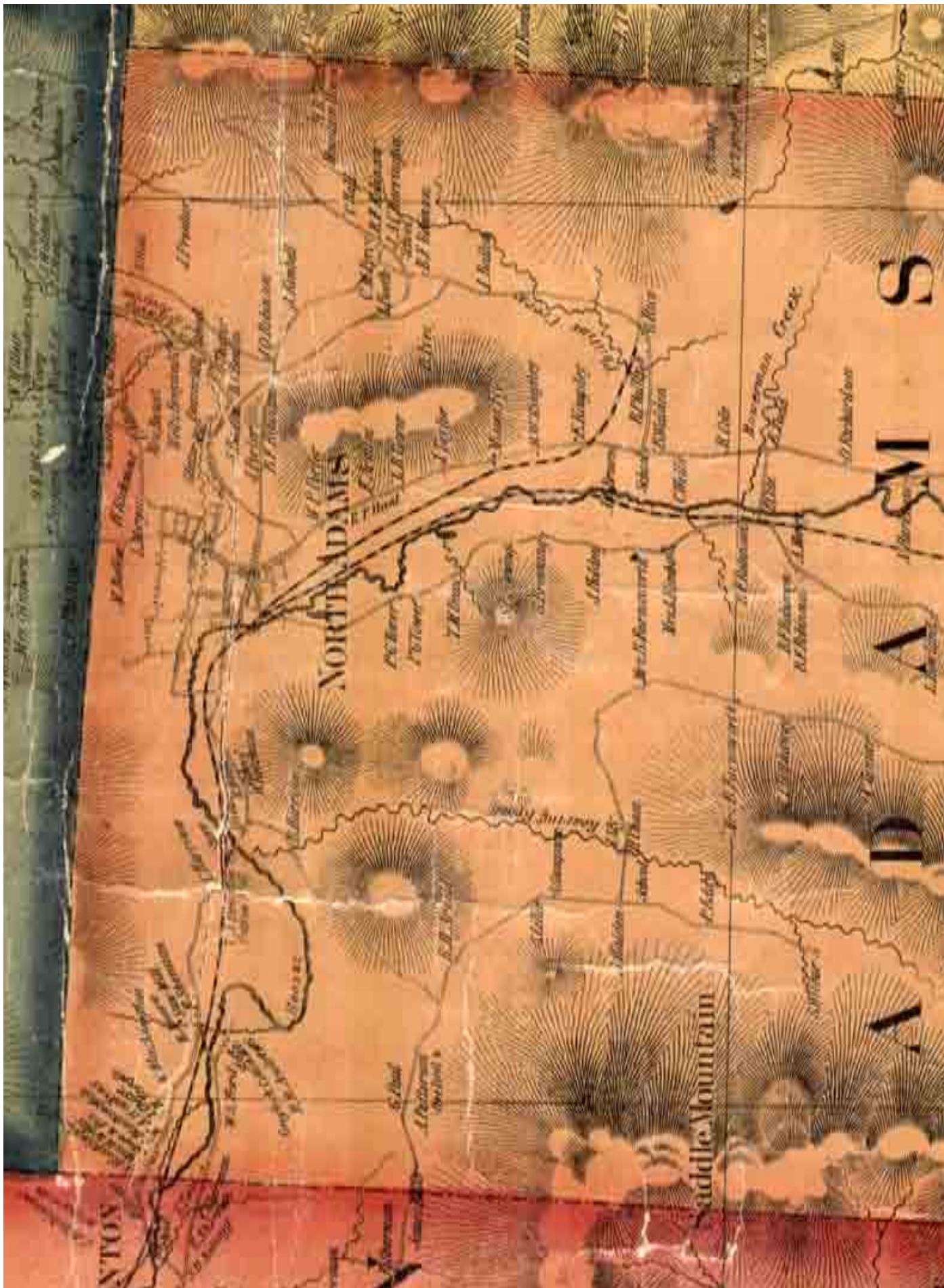


The original map is a large wall map measuring about 5' x 5'. The old wall map has been "taken apart" for this edition by scanning into separate images.

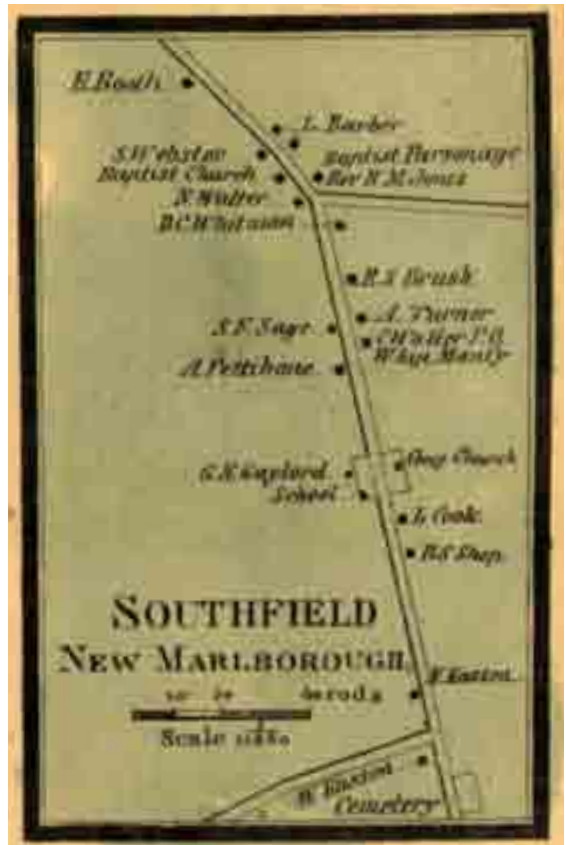


Map of Berkshire County, MA 1858 49

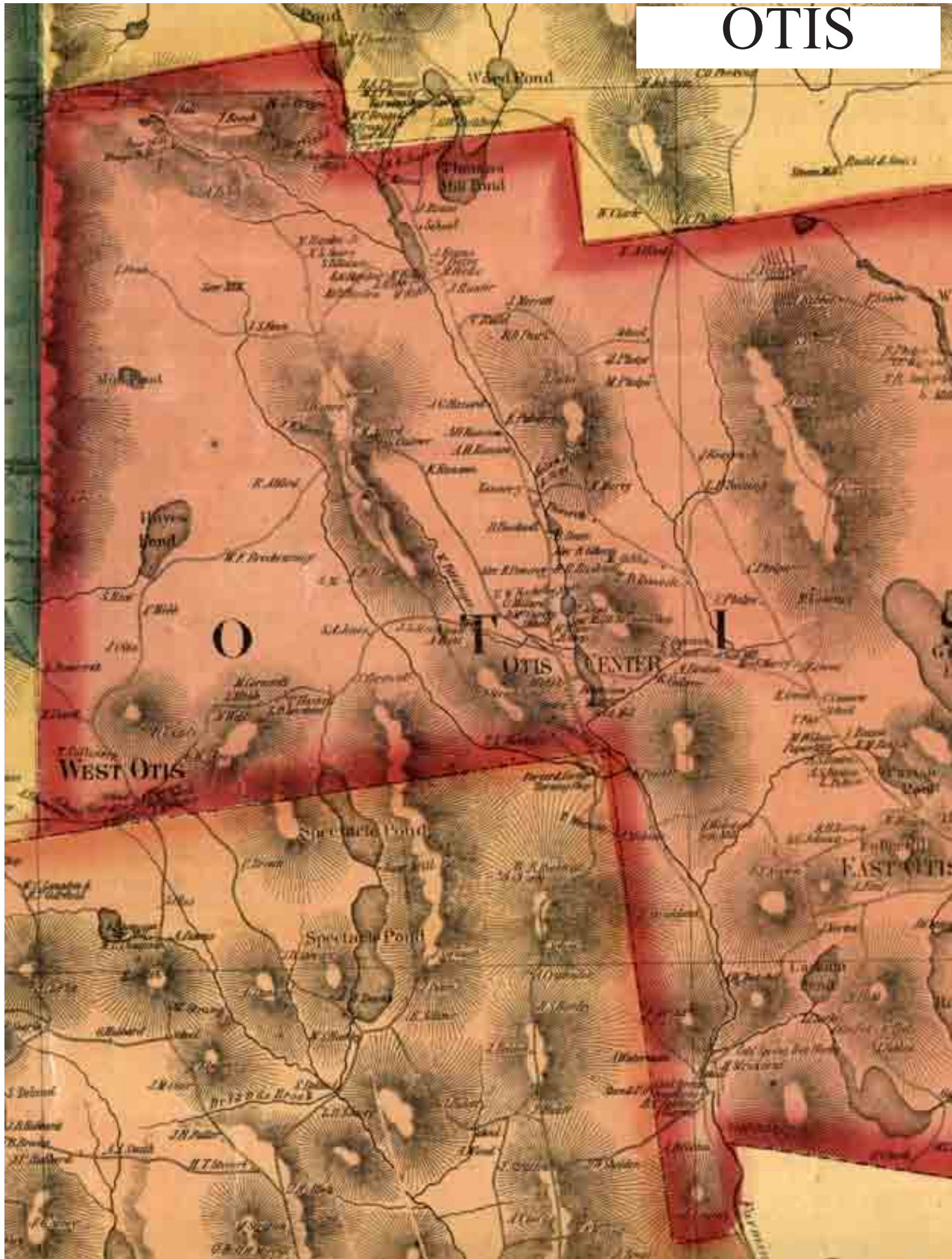
