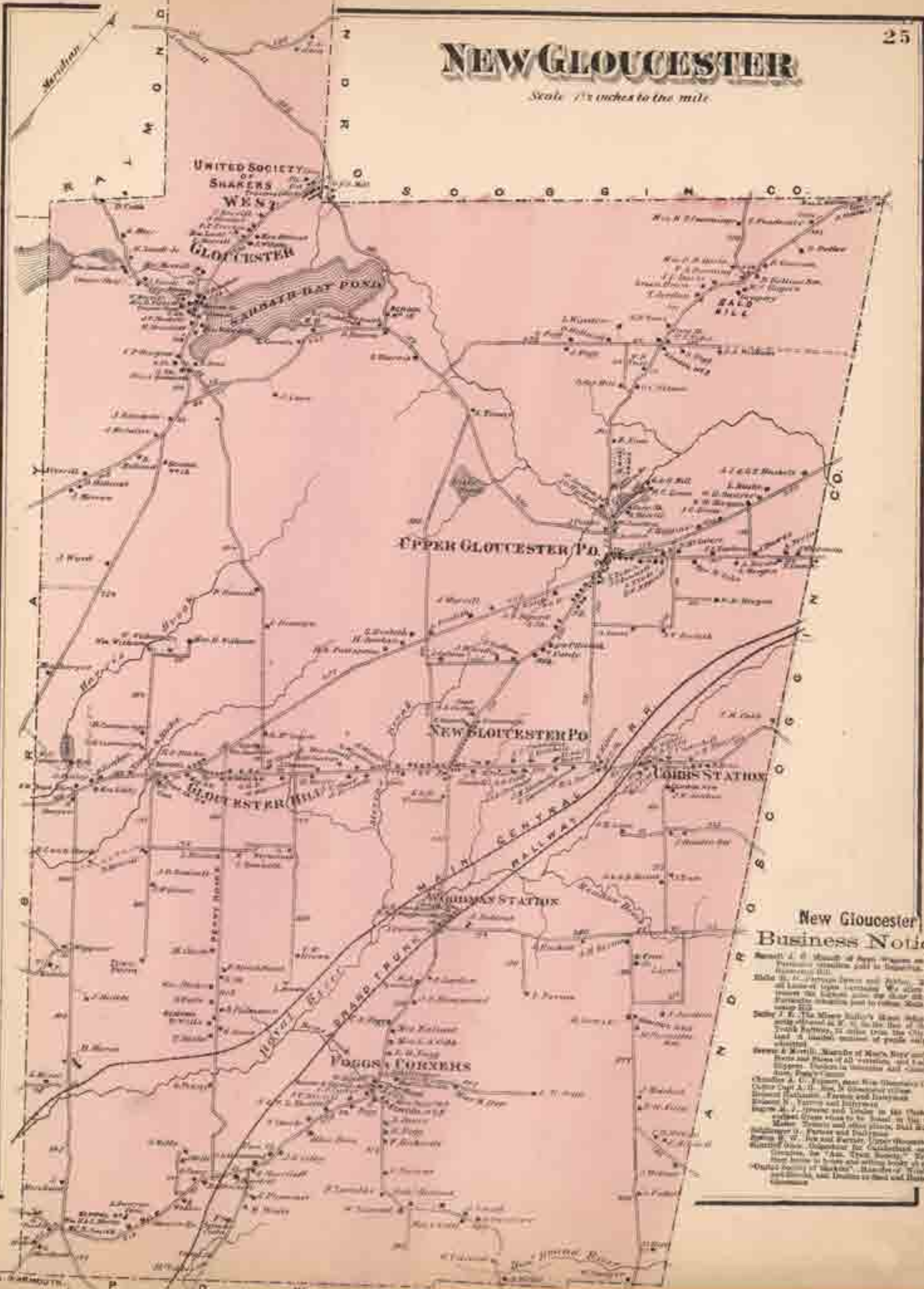
POPEVILLE

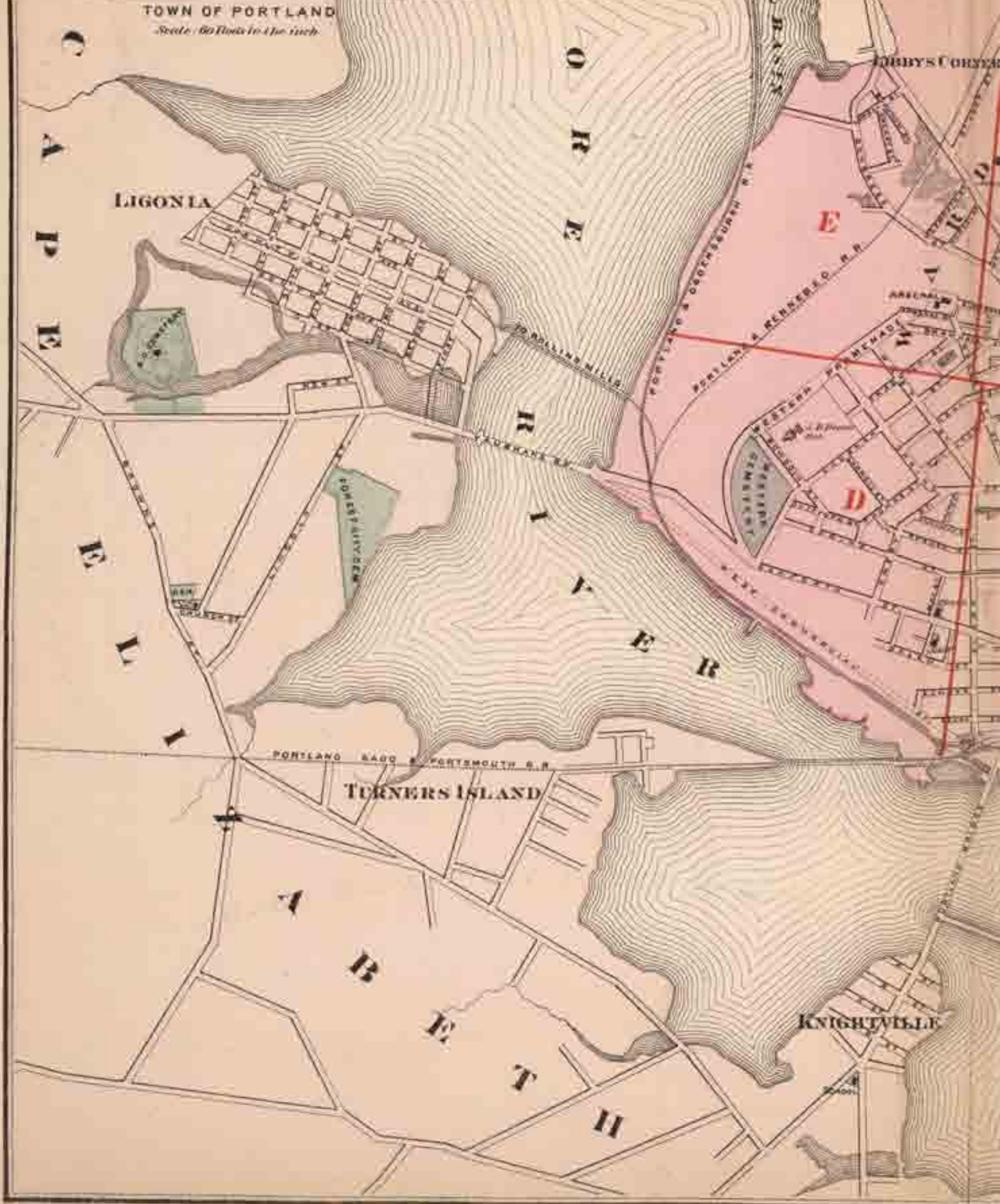


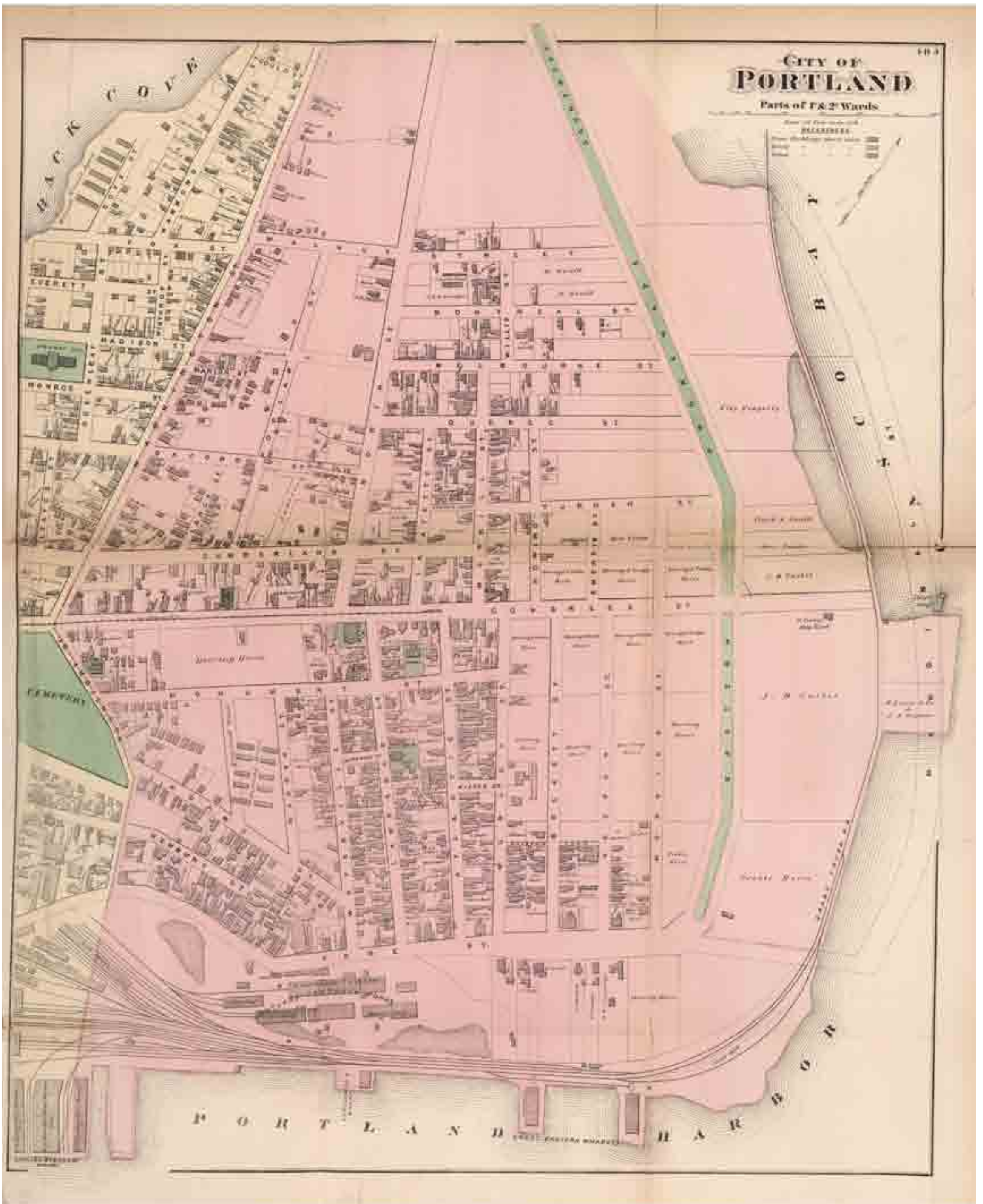


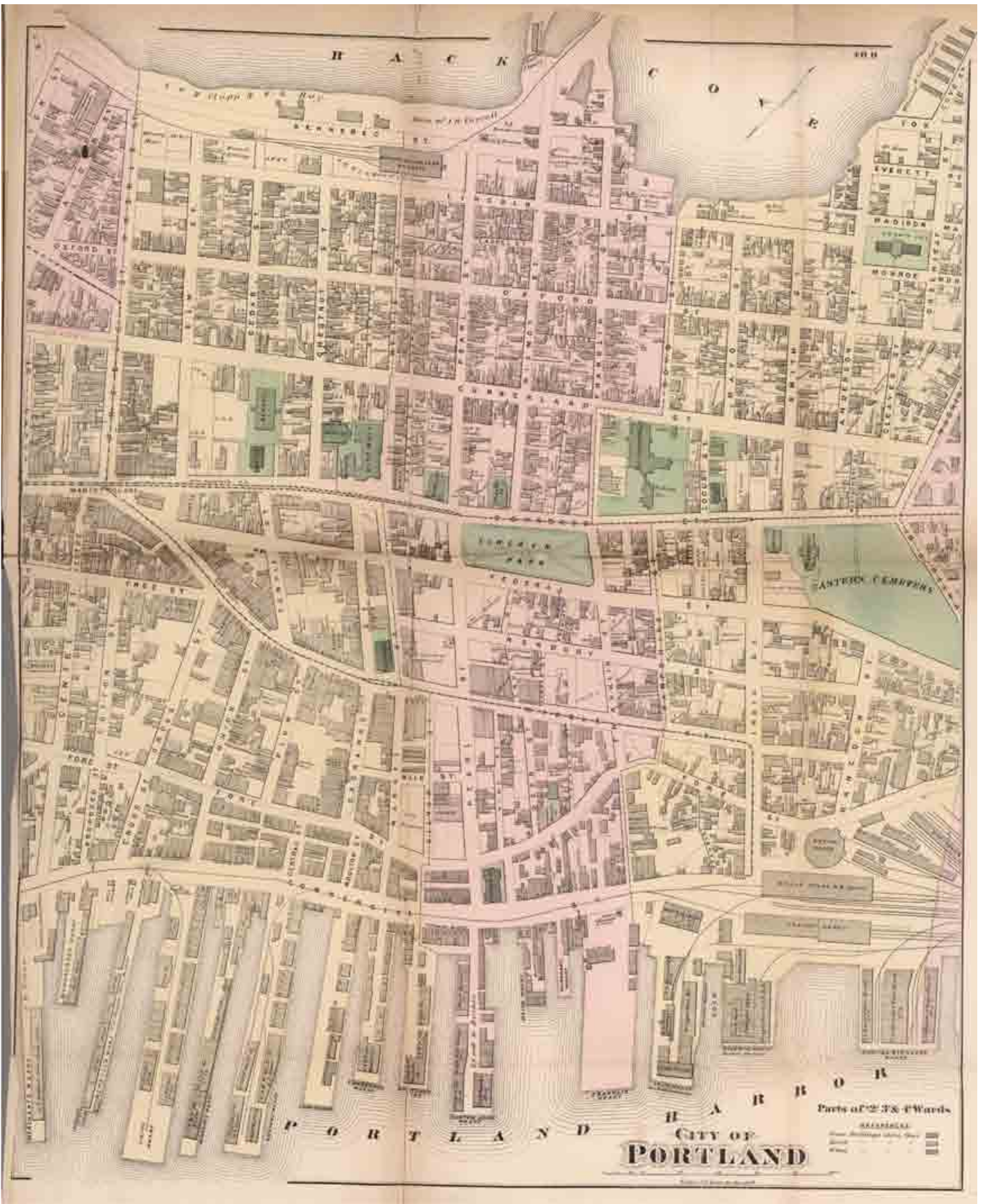
PORTLAND AND VICINITY

POLAND CORNERS

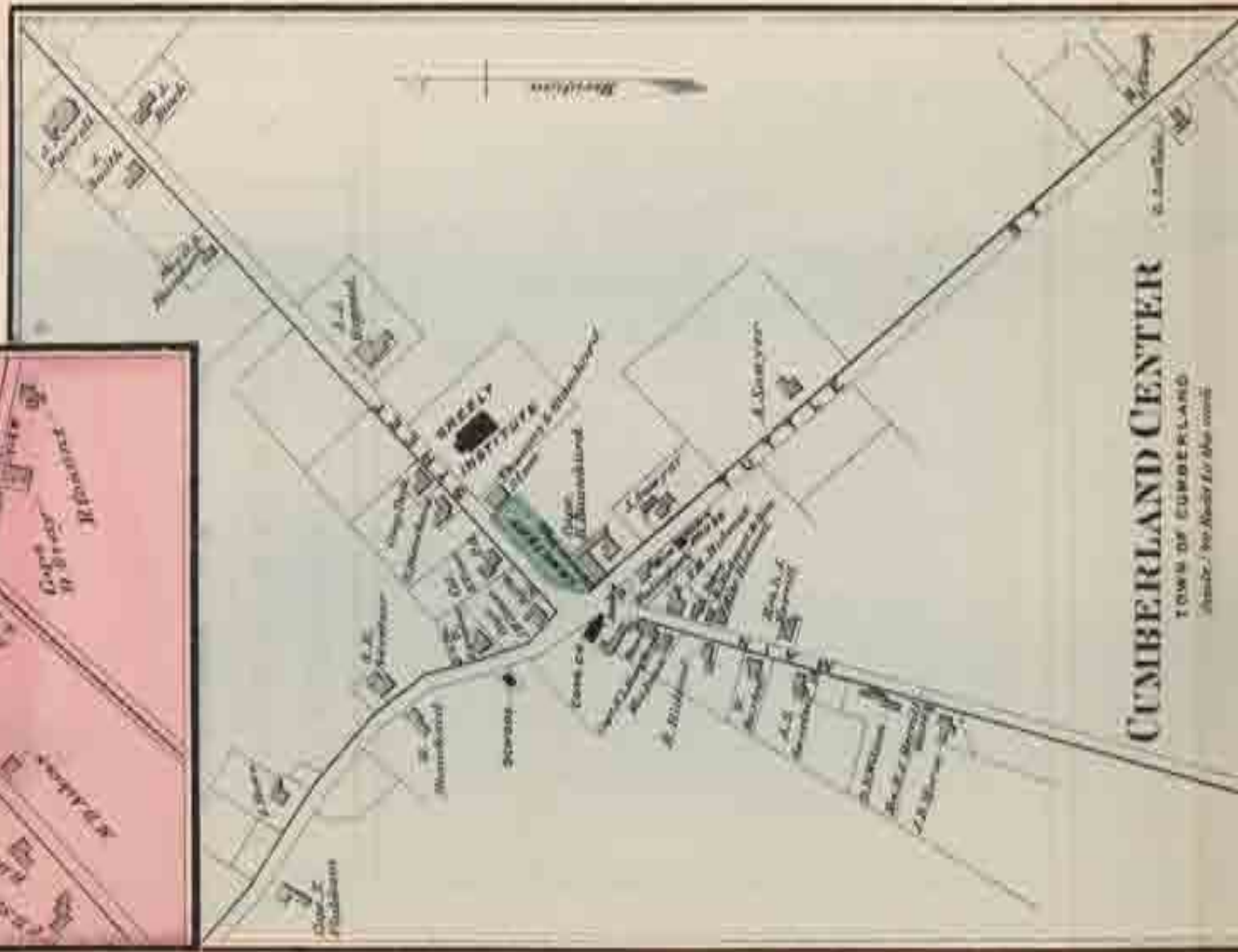

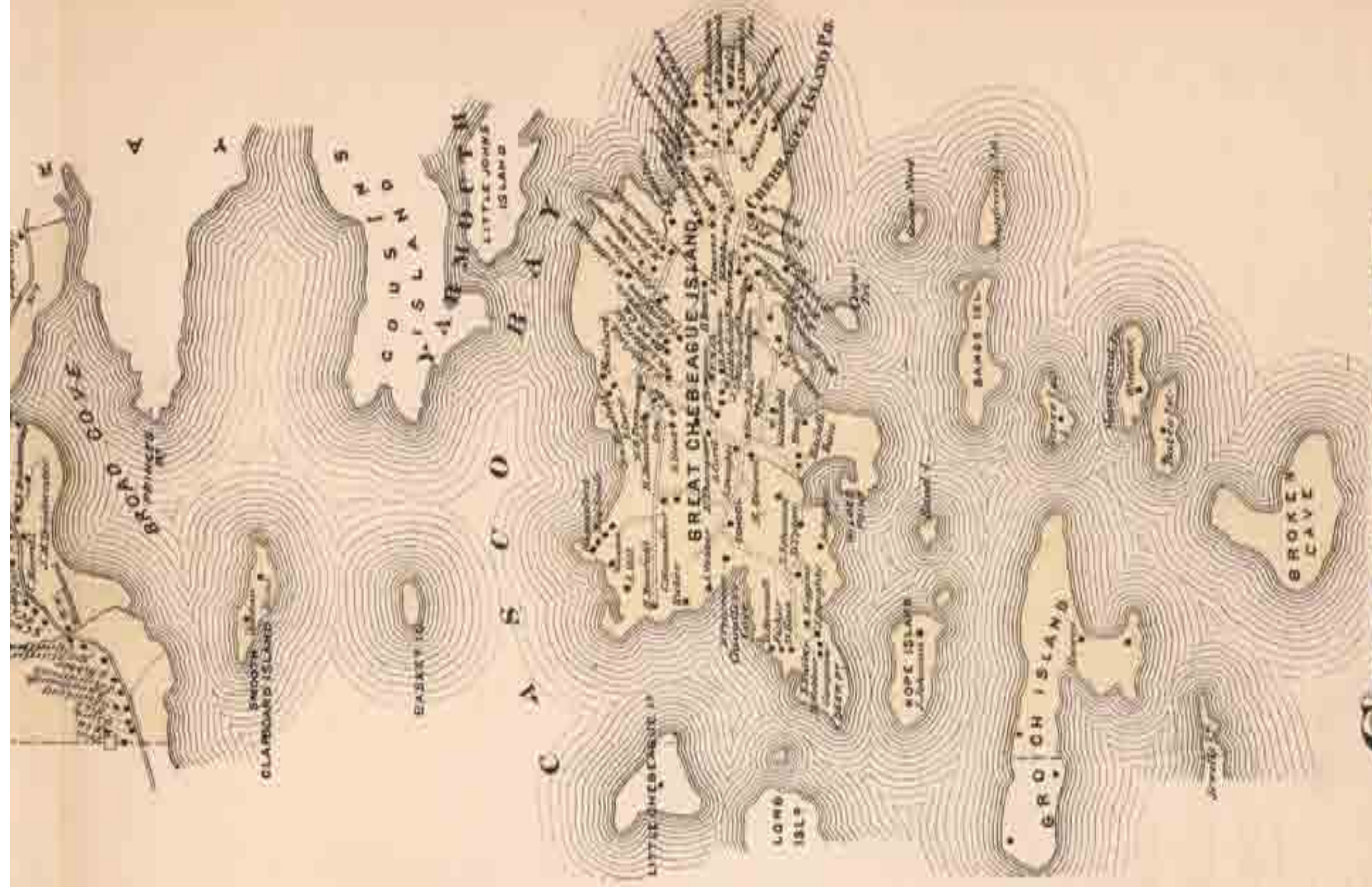
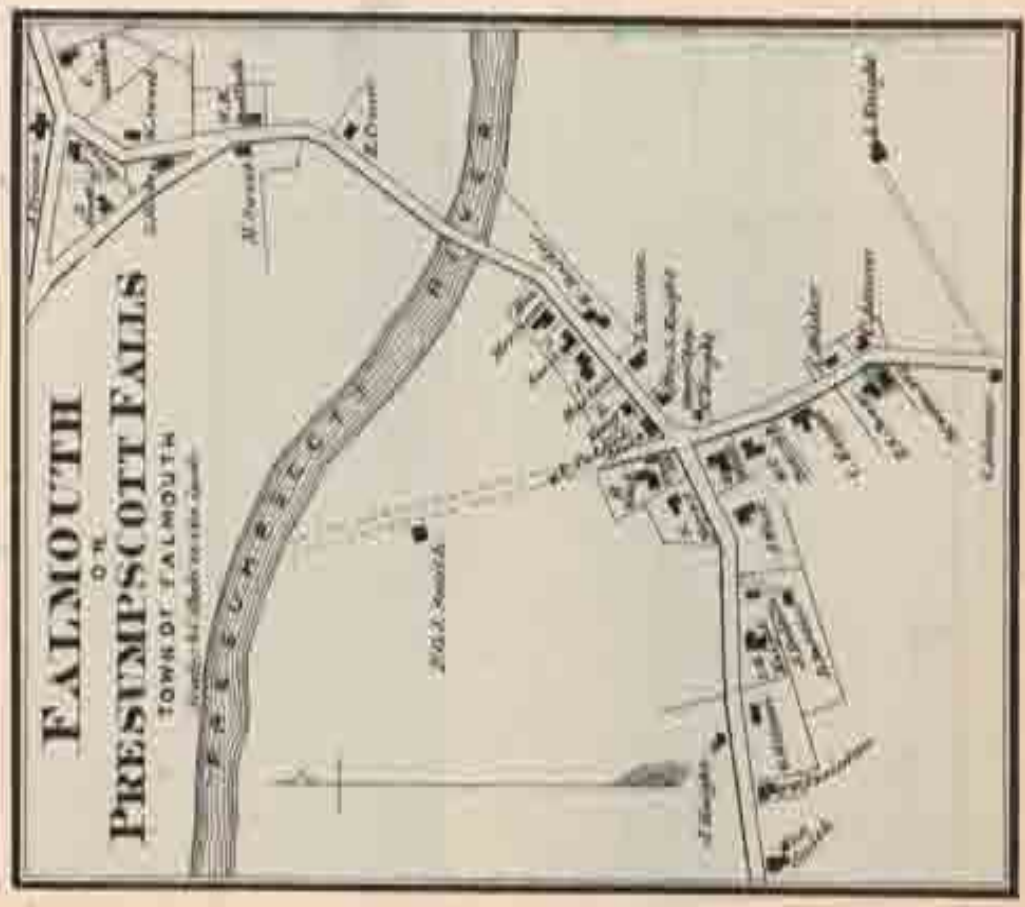


CUMBERLAND CENTER

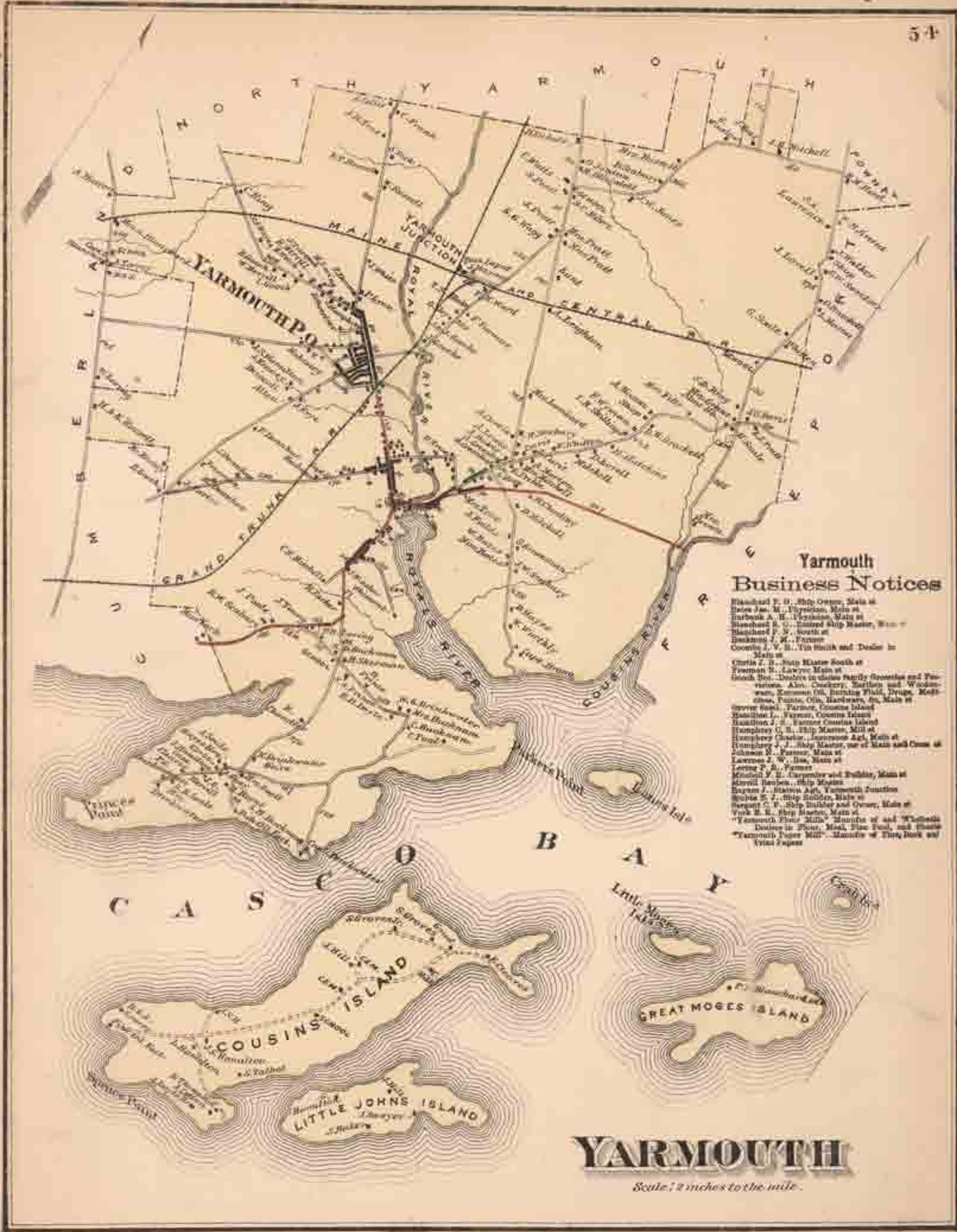
TOWN OF CUMBERLAND

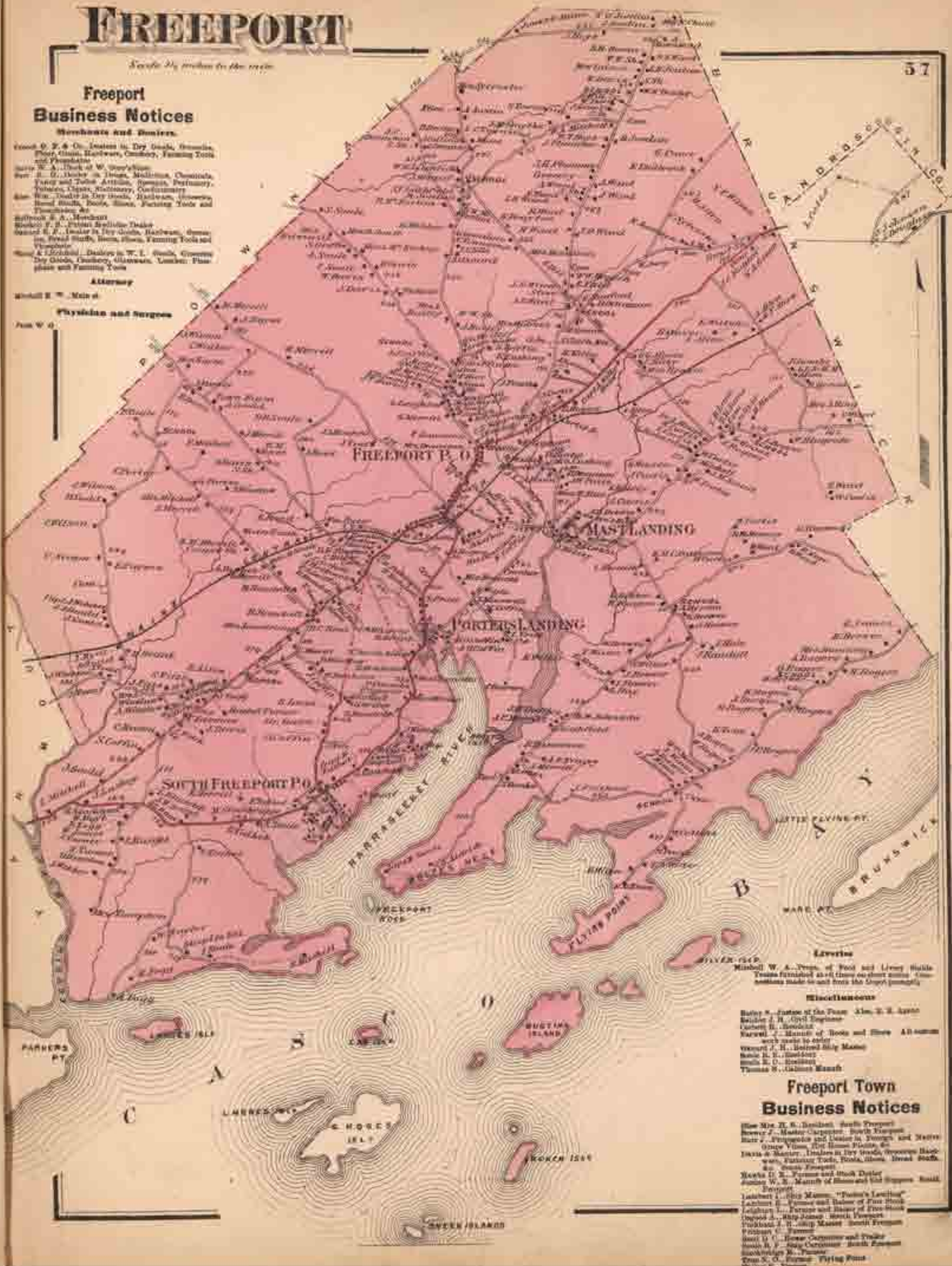
