Map of Middlesex County, Mass.



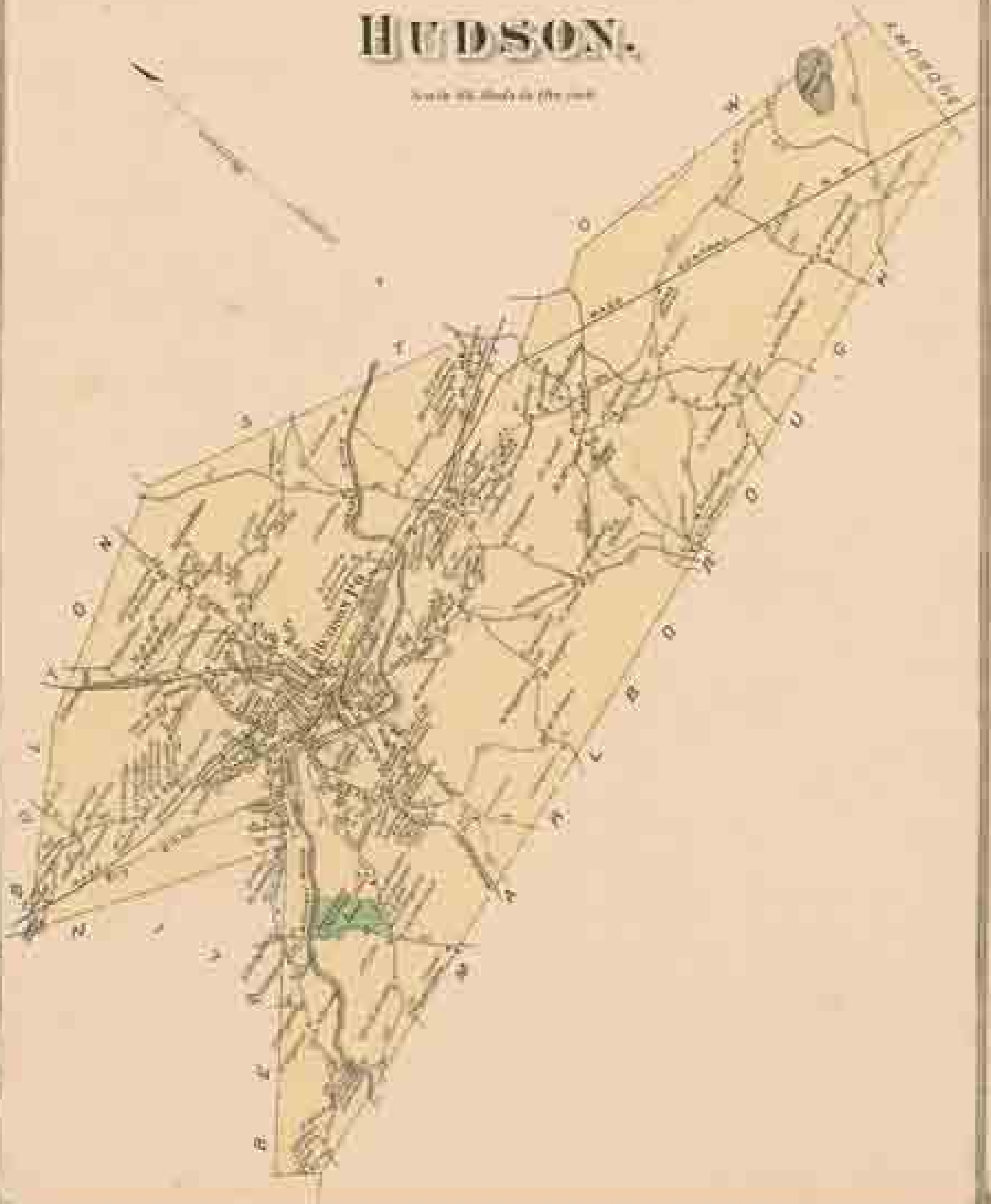

Language and Grammar.

Syntax and Sentences.
 Syntax is the study of the rules and principles that govern the arrangement of words in a sentence. Sentences are the basic units of communication.

Semantics and Meaning.
 Semantics is the study of the meaning of words and sentences. It involves understanding the relationship between words and the concepts they represent.

Pragmatics and Context.
 Pragmatics is the study of the use of language in context. It involves understanding how the meaning of a sentence can change depending on the situation in which it is used.

Discourse and Texts.
